Boudreaux's pharmacists help doctors solve patient problems. Over 2,500 physicians have written compounds with Boudreaux's, and they are a leading resource for physician consults.

"We have patient specified medication and tailor medicine to fit the patient. There is a huge need in Shreveport for this service," Doug says.

He also helped raise \$1.8 million worth of medicine that was donated to the Northwest Louisiana Interfaith Pharmacy for hurricane victims from all over the country. Doug is also a member of the Louisiana Board of Pharmacists.

But Doug will be quick to tell anyone that, "I could not have done all these things if not for my wife."

Two other staff pharmacists for Boudreaux's are Kirsten Palmer, P.D. and Melanie Parker, P.D. Kirsten is specially trained for chemo/investigational medications, allergy dilutions, pediatrics and bio-identical hormone replacement therapy. Melanie has training and experience in nutrition, pediatric intensive care and neonatal intensive care.

Boudreaux's also offers free patient consultation and free delivery of compounded medications, something rarely offered by area pharmacies.
